Count It! Lock It! Drop It!®



Don't Be An Accidental Drug Dealer



Count It! Monitor Your Rx Meds!

Make sure your medicine cabinet doesn't become an unintended "source." Count your pills often and check expiration dates to prevent theft and ensure proper use.

Lock It! Store Your Rx Drugs Safely!

Protect loved ones by using lock bags to securely store prescription medications. If not used properly, they can be as harmful and dangerous as illicit drugs.

Drop It! Dispose of Unwanted Rx Drugs!

Take advantage of drop boxes located at all local Police Station to dispose of unused or expired drugs. It's just too risky to leave them hanging around!
